



Graduate/Research Assistantship Opportunity

The Native American Budget and Policy Institute (NABPI) is seeking a master's/PhD level graduate/research assistant to become part of a team of researchers and professionals working together to empower Native American communities. The mission of NABPI is to improve health, education, and economic well-being through research, budget and policy analysis, social justice advocacy, litigation and community lawyering. This is a great opportunity to learn and work with tribal communities.

The graduate assistant will support the NABPI team on research projects that include, but not limited to quantitative and qualitative data analysis, community-based engagement, and grant and contract proposal development.

Position Requirements:

- Experience with data analysis (either quantitative or qualitative)
- Experience with engaging tribal communities and agencies
- Effective writing and communication skills

Preference:

- Knowledge of power-point, excel, STATA, SPSS
- Experience writing or assisting with the writing of policy reports

The assistantship will be a .25 FTE or .50 FTE (10hrs/20hrs per week) at \$17.00 - \$20.00/hour dependent on MA or PhD level. Anticipated start date will be fall break and into the Spring semester of 2022.
